

English Language Placement Test Instructions

These instructions are called "The English Language Placement Tests Instructions " which are applied at the beginning of each academic year to Philadelphia University students from various majors.

Article (1): All new students admitted into Philadelphia University must sit for the placement test at the beginning of every academic year.

Article (2): A student may sit once or twice for the Arabic and English placement tests. The student is allowed to take the exam for the duration of two years after being admitted into the University. When the second year comes to an end, the placement test would not be allowed for this student anymore. If a student does not pass any of these placement tests, he has to study the relevant remedial course.

Article (3): The University President, upon the recommendation of the Language Center Director, forms a committee of specialists in the Arabic and English Languages with the aim of setting and computerizing the exam. The committee includes academic staff members who work at the Language Center, Faculty of Arts, and Faculty of Information Technology. Committee members are assigned to set, update and develop the exam's questions. They are also assigned to supervise the exam's programming and to extract and process students' results.

Article (4): All students who succeed in the Arabic and English placement tests, regardless of their marks in the test, have to study Arabic Skills 1 and English Skills 1.
