Submission Guidelines Regular Papers

Papers must be submitted electronically by October 30, 2006. Each paper will be evaluated by at least three reviewers, and will be accepted based on its originality, significance and clarity. Papers must not exceed 6,000 words or 20 pages double spaced 10-12-point font. Papers must not be published or under consideration to be published elsewhere.

Short Papers

Submitted papers that are deemed of good quality but could not be accepted as regular papers will be accepted as short papers.

Posters and Doctoral Symposium

Research still in early stages and doctoral research proposals may be submitted as extended abstracts that must not exceed 750 words. Accepted abstracts will be included in a special poster session dedicated to doctoral research proposals and related research. Extended abstracts should be submitted directly to the Posters Chairs.

Workshops Tutorials and Panels Submissions

Proposals for workshops, tutorials and panels should be submitted directly to the appropriate chair.
